September 2008 Playground Area Complete of Margaret Bowater Park

The Corner Brook Stream Development Corporation has had a busy summer at Margaret Bowater Park; and it shows! Work began last fall in partnership with the City of Corner Brook to revitalize the north side of this beloved city landmark. Phase 1 of the park re-development is now complete and getting rave reviews from the public.

The new playground equipment is colorful, safe, and most importantly fun! Site design incorporates walking trails in the equipment layout along with a beautifully landscaped rest area. One of the more notable features is the new lighting system which extends play time in the evenings and provides for a more secure environment year round. The park is also better served by a new asphalt parking area which guides access to and from O’Connell Drive.

A generous donation by the Corner Brook Elks Club funded the acquisition of several pieces designed to accommodate physically challenged children.
